

Usage, Proofreading, and Editing Online Content

Course Description

In this course, students move beyond mechanical editing and focus compyediting for grammar and usage that can be harder to identify as incorrect. Students learn the difference between copyediting and proofreading, how to be a good proofreader, and the basic procedure for completing a proofread. Visual design and the physical features of documents are also discussed. Students are introduced to editing online content such as web pages and online help systems. This course builds on Course 1 of the certificate and continues to build a foundation for Course 3.

Outcome

Students who successfully complete their course of study will be able to:

- Look beyond mechanical editing and copyedit documents for grammar and usage.
- Identify the differences between copyediting and proofreading.
- Perform a proofread on a document.
- Understand how visual design helps guide readers and present information, and how to edit for visual design.
- Copyedit an online help system.
- Copyedit a web site.

Assessment

Each unit in this course offers a required, graded assignment along with an optional self-assessment to help you measure your progress and mastery of the materials. A score of 80 or higher is required to complete the course successfully.
